

Smart Starter Expectations

- We will frequently begin class by doing a Smart Starter warm up
- All Smart Starters need to be in your Interactive Notebook on the appropriate page
- Please use the Table of Contents to determine which page that week's Smart Starters should be placed and number that page correctly
 - Example – Week 1 Smart Starters will all go on page 4 of your Interactive Notebook
- If you know that you write large, you will want to save an extra page in your notebook to have additional room (this will not change your page numbers; you will just have a second page 4)

Smart Starter Procedures

- Write the title for the week at the top of your page
 - Example – Week 1 Smart Starters (SS 1-5)
 - SS stands for Smart Starters
 - The numbers refer to the day of school (Tuesday, 8/25 is day 2 and will be SS 2)
- After writing the title for the week, skip one line
- In the left-hand margin write the number for the Smart Starter
 - Example – SS 1
- Regardless of if we have a smart starter, you will always write the SS number in the margin; if we skip that smart starter (such as we did on the first day of school), please write none next to the number
- You are not required to rewrite the question and you are not required to write in the form of a complete sentence; you ARE required to attempt every question
- We will discuss each smart starter daily, so correct your answer as we check them to receive full credit
- Skip one line between each question
- If you were absent, you are still expected to complete the smart starter (these can be found in your teacher's master copy of the Interactive Notebook, teacher website, and will be given to you in hard copy)
